We would also like to post a few reminders that will keep your community looking great!

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## Reminders:

1. All garbage containers and recycling bins may not be stored outside unless in an enclosed area.\* see Article 4 specifically 4.8 of the Declaration of Restrictions for further details.
2. Parking of any vehicle on any portion of the grass, lawn or sidewalk is prohibited. Additionally, overnight parking of recreational vehicle, camper or boat is prohibited.\* see Article 4, specifically 4.16.4 and 4.16.1 of the Declaration of Restrictions for further details.
3. Mowing or trimming to the adjacent lake or bank of any water-body is the responsibility of the homeowner.\*see Article 5 specifically 5.2 of the Declaration of Restrictions for further details.



# Accomplishments:

1. Removal of unsightly weeds and overgrowth behind lake 4 and the planting of over 4000 aquatic plants on the littoral shelf as required by the Sarasota County Department of Environmental Services.
2. Replacement of over 5000 square feet of sod along Woodmere Boulevard.
3. Lighting along the sidewalk area near the school bus pick up location on Hemingway Drive.
4. Contract negotiations and renewals of irrigation, lake and mowing/landscaping.
5. Request for median re-design proposals from several local landscape and design companies.
6. Deposit of a portion of reserve funds into an interest bearing certificate of deposit resulting in added revenues.


